On 2nd August, the Franciscan Family keeps the Feast of Our Lady of the Angels! This is the patronal title of the Blessed Virgin under which St. Francis placed the Order. St. Francis had great devotion to Our Lady under this title due to his repairing of the little chapel of the "Portiuncula" (little portion) in the woods outside Assisi and becoming devoted to it as a place of

prayer and meditation in which the earliest brothers gathered and where St. Clare was first received into her vows. St. Francis also had a number of visions of Our Lady and the Angels and received the famous privilege of the "Pardon of Assisi" from the Pope, (a plenary indulgence) Finally, it was at the Portiuncula that Francis greeted Sister Death and passed to the Lord in the year 1226. This year on the Feast of Our Lady of the Angels, the Capuchin Franciscan communities change following the recent Capuchin Chapter. The changes in Church Street are:
